The Seattle Horseshoe Club has lost most of the long time pitchers including Bob Hansen, Orlean Clinton, Norm Hansen, and Dick Lee. I believe Ted (embarrassed because I am blanking on his last name, Bostwick?) was originally a Seattle Horseshoe Club member as well. When pitchers from our club throw "4 dead", we call out "For Ted" in honor of him. We miss all of them partly because we cannot pitch with them anymore, but mostly because they were our friends who encouraged and advised us, mentored us, and represented the sport of horseshoes professionally.

WSHPA AWARDS PROGRAM

For the sake of our many new pitchers, I'd like to go over our Plate and Plaque award procedure.

First of all – WELCOME to all our brand new members. It is so good to see new faces in the crowd.

In all Washington sanctioned tournaments (except the Pacific N.W.) plates are issued for the top finishers in each class. After receiving your first (5) five plates, you are then given a Washington State plaque to display your plates. Each plaque holds 18 plates. When you have earned #19, you then can purchase an additional plaque for \$25.00.

All plates and plaques are handed out at the State Tournament in September for that current year.

- In a 4 person class - 1st place plate only is given 5 - 6 person class - 1st & 2nd place plates only
- 7 - 8 person class – 1st, 2nd & 3rd place plates only
- 9 -10 person class – 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th plates only

For any questions you might have – be sure and ask. Us old timers sometimes forget that this is a new experience for the 1st time pitcher. There are no dumb questions – on occasion there might be a dumb answer!!






