HALL OF FAME INFORMATION

Induction into the Hall of Fame is a very special honor and criteria for selection of nominees should be maintained at the highest level. This honor should be given only to those who have significantly contributed to the sport of horseshoes. Following are areas to consider for qualifications:

- Active participation
- Promotion and dedication
- Sportsmanship on and off courts
- Ability

A dossier detailing a complete history of the candidate’s activities in horseshoe, etc. must be submitted to the Hall of Fame chairperson by May 1st of any given year.

There are five appointed persons on the Hall of Fame committee and each individual votes on a point basis. A required number of points determine if a candidate is selected for induction.

Be sure and check out the ‘Wall of Fame’ in our Horseshoe & Museum Trailer at the State Tournament this year in Burlington. That wall depicts the story of our history and all who have contributed to that history. It is indeed an honor.

I, Phyl Quist, am the H of F chairperson this year. Submit any dossiers to P.O. Box 517, Ferndale, WA 98248 by May 1.

As a reminder the deadline for entries to the World Tournament in Florence, South Caroline is fast approaching. The deadline per the tournament schedule is May 14th. The entry forms are on the NHPA website. They also have a way to enter and pay online as well.






