RGS 2016

RULE 12 - APPROPRIATE NHPA MEMBER CONDUCT

Section B - Sportsmanship

Any NHPA member who indulges in heckling or unfair rooting, uses profanity or abusive language, makes obscene gestures, or exhibits any other form of un-sportsmanlike conduct toward the contestants, Tournament/League Officials, or other NHPA members who are in the area of the courts, may be subject to expulsion from the Tournament/League and from the Tournament/League site. This member may also be subject to a one (1) year suspension from the NHPA (see Bylaws and page 34 for additional information).





WINETROUT WINTER OPEN RINGER CLASSIC

This series of 6 tournaments from January through March gives those of us who brave the elements, a chance to get our pitching skills up to a competitive level as early as possible. They also serve as a way to encourage our members to renew their state and national memberships in a timely fashion. The mileage trophy is awarded to the pitcher who has traveled the most miles, one way and competes in at least 5 of the series. The winner of the most improved percentage trophy must also compete in at least 5 of the series. Pitchers cannot win either trophy more than once. At the conclusion of the series, a mens, womens, and elders champion are named and presented with a plaque.

Scoring for the Winetrouts is also a little different. Scoring consists of counting ringers only by each pitcher in games of 40 shoes. First pitch is alternating and class winners are determined by win/loss record.
