### WINETROUT WINTER OPEN RINGER CLASSIC

This series of 6 tournaments from January through March gives those of us who brave the elements, a chance to get our pitching skills up to a competitive level as early as possible. They also serve as a way to encourage our members to renew their state and national memberships in a timely fashion. The mileage trophy is awarded to the pitcher who has traveled the most miles, one way and competes in at least 5 of the series. The winner of the most improved percentage trophy must also compete in at least 5 of the series. Pitchers cannot win either trophy more than once. At the conclusion of the series, a mens, womens, and elders champion are named and presented with a plaque.

Scoring for the Winetrouts is also a little different. Scoring consists of counting ringers only by each pitcher in games of 40 shoes. First pitch is alternating and class winners are determined by win/loss record.

*Let's plan on dusting off our shoes and warming up for the 2018 season at the Winetrouts!*

Alice & Wally were the founders of the Spokane horseshoe club along with Chuck & Velma Holden, Ross & Helen Watson, and Ed & Ruth Welsh. Many tournaments were named for Wally and Ed. Wally was especially known for painstakingly learning to pitch with his left arm, after losing the ability to pitch with his right arm. Alice was also a faithful associate member for many years.



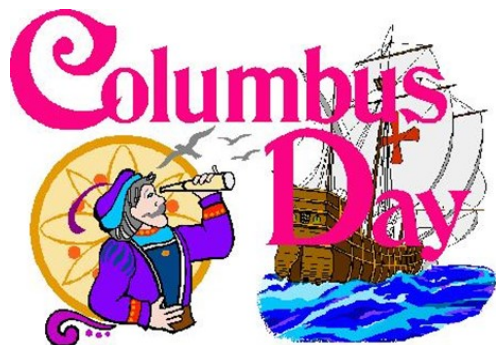
